Range Rules, All members are to attend a range rules safety class Shooting Hours: Monday thru Saturday – 9:00 am till dusk Sunday – 11:00 am till dusk

Range will be Closed Easter Sunday and Christmas Day to respect our neighbors

There is no shooting during club activities

Use of Intoxicants with firearms is **prohibited** at Louisville Sportsman's Club

Rifle Range

Pistol shooting on the rifle range, as long as the target is set at the 100 yard mark Only use paper or card board targets

Use the movable bench if shooting less then 100 yards

Example: if shooting 50 yards, place the bench 50 yards back from the dirt pile

No hanging targets, all targets must be at the 100 yard mark

Never handle firearms while another shooter is down range

Use of an empty chamber is highly recommended, when anyone is down range firearms are to unloaded and in the gun rack in an upright position

Use of an alternative target is to be approved by a board member or range officer only

Utility Range

Maximum height of targets is 5 feet from the top of the target

40 Yard maximum (big tree) shooting on the range (no shooting from or across the driveway) Only use paper or cardboard targets

Never handle firearms while another shooter is down range

Use of an empty chamber is highly recommended, when anyone is down range firearms are to unloaded and in the gun rack in an upright position or pointing away from the targets Use of an alternative target is to be approved by a board member or range officer only

Members can bring a friend, Membership should be suggested
You must carry your membership card at all time when on club property
(There has been people sneaking in to use the range)
A member has preference over a non membership
When come to shoot, please do not lock the gate behind you while using the facility
Please lock the gate if you are the last one to leave
